Pentavalente Acelular = DTaP+IPV+Hib (After August 2007)
 Triple Viral SRP = MMR Cuadruple = DPT + Hib
 Pentavalente = DPT + Hib + Hep B (Prior to July 2007)

Vaccination Combinations

Pediarix = DTaP + IPV + Hep B Pentacel = DTaP + IPV + Hib
 ProQuad(MMRV) = MMR + Varicella Comvax = Hep B + Hib
 Kinrix = DTaP + IPV Tetramune = DTaP + Hib
